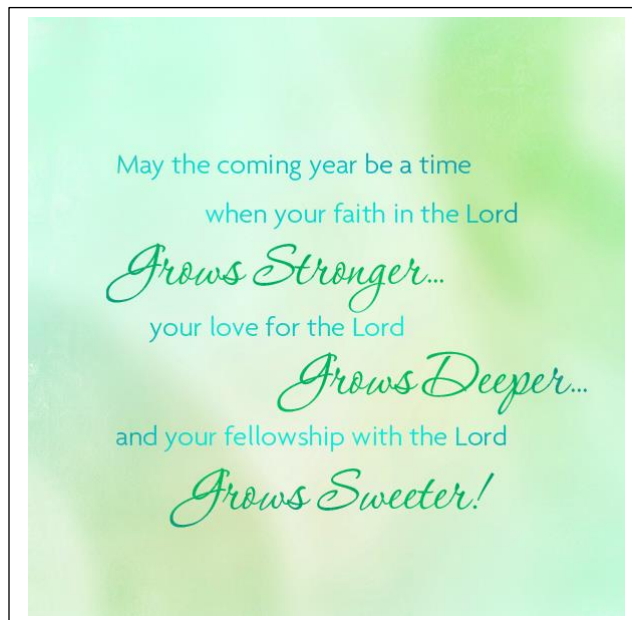

Looking back on last year's experiences I have to admit I had some uncomfortable moments. Starting the New Year 2014, I frequently heard "God is going to do a new thing." I found myself trying to finish my studies with no full-time employment, very unsure about my future, how I was going to make it.
